## TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Eligible bowlers will be members of Linn-Benton USBC.
2. Physically handicapped: A bowler who requires special aids must report in writing when entry is submitted.
3. Multiple participation: Teams may enter as many times as you wish, changing at least 2 members each entry. Doubles, you enter as many times as you wish, changing partners each entry. Singles and all events, you may enter one time only. The first score only in each event will count towards all events.
4. Average: Entrants shall use their highest USBC sanctioned average in the following order:
  - a. Highest 2018-2019 book average of 21 games or more
  - b. Highest current average of 21 games or more as of January 1, 2020.
  - c. Highest 2019 summer average of 21 games or more
  - d. If the bowler does not have one of the above, the entrant must use an average of 220
5. Entries close at noon on February, 28 2020. Late entries will be accepted with approval of the tournament Board of Directors.
6. This is a handicap tournament. The handicap will be calculated 90% of 220.
7. Entry fees: \$15.00 per person, per event. Optional All Events is \$5.00 per person.
8. Lane assignments are randomly selected. There is no guarantee that you will not bowl on the same pair of lanes in different events. Lane assignments will only be changed on an emergency basis at the discretion of the tournament director(s).
9. The lineup for bowling will be the same as shown on the tournament entry form.
10. Check-In: Team captain is responsible for checking her entire team in 30 minutes prior to scheduled bowling time. Each bowler must check in 30 minutes prior to the doubles and singles events.
11. Any player or team arriving after the game had started will be allowed to bowl and the score will be counted beginning in the current frame being bowled. No score will be given for missed frames.
12. Substitutes: Substitutes are allowed. Please advise tournament director one hour prior to scheduled bowling time. In the event of an emergency, a substitute will be allowed after a game has started in team and doubles events only. The combined scores of the entrant and the substitute will be counted. If no substitute is available, the scores of the frames bowled only will be counted. A substitute is not required to reimburse original entrant for entry fee paid or to give original entrant any prize money or awards won by the substitute.
13. When players are scheduled to bowl unopposed, they must bowl as though they were actually contested. The players shall complete one frame on one lane before the leadoff bowler begins the next frame on the adjoining lane.
14. Any protest affecting eligibility or playing rules must be brought to the attention of the tournament director(s) immediately. Obvious errors shall be corrected under the jurisdiction of the tournament director(s). Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament staff immediately. Players may NOT correct scoring errors. Only tournament monitors and USBC Board members will be allowed to correct scores.
15. Co-champions shall be declared in the event of a tie. First and second place prize money will be divided equally.
16. The tournament pay ration will be approximately 1:4 for team event and 1:5 for singles, doubles and all events.
17. Entry Fee: Lineage \$8.75, Prize Fund \$5.25, Expenses \$1.00
18. Averages may be rerated by the tournament director(s).
19. USBC playing rules will be used for all issues not covered under the tournament rules. The USBC tournament committee shall decide questions not covered by these rules.
20. If you are signed up to bowl, there will be no refunds for not bowling. However, you may get a qualified substitute to bowl in your place.
21. Dress code: the following are NOT allowed: spandex clothing, tank tops, low cut tops or short shorts, cutoffs or anything that allows for a bare midriff or visible cleavage. Team captains are responsible for ensuring that all team members comply with the dress code. Bowlers wearing inappropriate clothing will not be allowed to bowl.
22. The entrants or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the USBC and its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants are prevented from bowling in any event in the tournament through premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency, or emergencies or causes related to or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of USBC.
23. Times selected may be changed depending on the number of participants for that particular squad. Team Captains will be notified if a change is necessary.
